**Floor Resolution #2 – Horizon Safety Recognition – Aviation’s First Responders**

WHEREAS, Horizon AFA members Josh Haimes and Gini Rutz noticed that a woman was unconscious in the lobby of their layover hotel in Kalispell, Montana, and

WHEREAS, Josh and Gini immediately reacted in their capacity as Aviation’s First Responder requesting an AED and notifying the hotel to call 911, and

WHEREAS, the hotel could not reach 911 and didn’t know if they had an AED, and

WHEREAS, Josh searched the hotel, finally locating the AED, and

WHEREAS, Gini and the pilots ran outside and flagged down a police car, and

WHEREAS, they performed CPR and used the AED until an ambulance arrived, and

WHEREAS, unfortunately, their efforts were not successful in reviving the guest,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that AFA-CWA recognizes Josh Haimes and Gini Rutz for their heroic efforts to save the life of a fellow hotel guest, and

THEREFORE BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that AFA-CWA presents its Safety Certification of Recognition to Josh and Gini for their quick reaction as Aviation’s First Responders.
