RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Alaska Safety Recognition – Erin Willison, Angie Senter, and Paulina Aguilar

PROPOSED RESOLUTION:

WHEREAS, Alaska Airlines AFA Members Erin Willison, Angie Senter, and Paulina Aguilar were assigned to work as the Flight Attendant crew on Alaska Airlines Flight 422 from Seattle to Chicago-O’Hare on July 11, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, shortly after take-off, a passenger stood up and began acting aggressively, loudly making threatening comments to other passengers on board; and,

WHEREAS, the Flight Attendants quickly worked to manage the situation and potential threat by enlisting the help of able-bodied passengers to subdue and restrain the threatening passenger in accordance with their training; and,

WHEREAS, while the Flight Attendants were handling the situation with the threatening passenger, several passengers developed health-related concerns that the Flight Attendants addressed; and,

WHEREAS, the Flight Attendants handled multiple onboard situations while maintaining clear control of the aircraft cabin and ensuring the safety and health of all passengers onboard;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that AFA-CWA recognizes Erin Willison, Angie Senter, and Paulina Aguilar for their efforts in the face of multiple situations that threatened the health and safety of everyone onboard the aircraft; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that AFA-CWA presents its Safety Certification of Recognition to Erin Willison, Angie Senter, and Paulina Aguilar for their true professionalism as Safety Professionals and Aviation’s First Responders.
