WHEREAS, AFA Miami Air Flight Attendants Radmilla Rusalic, Melissa Gonzalez, Luis Quinones, and Amira "Florentine" Hoven safely evacuated all passengers from the plane, and

WHEREAS, Passengers praised the actions of Aviation's First Responders working Flight 293.
